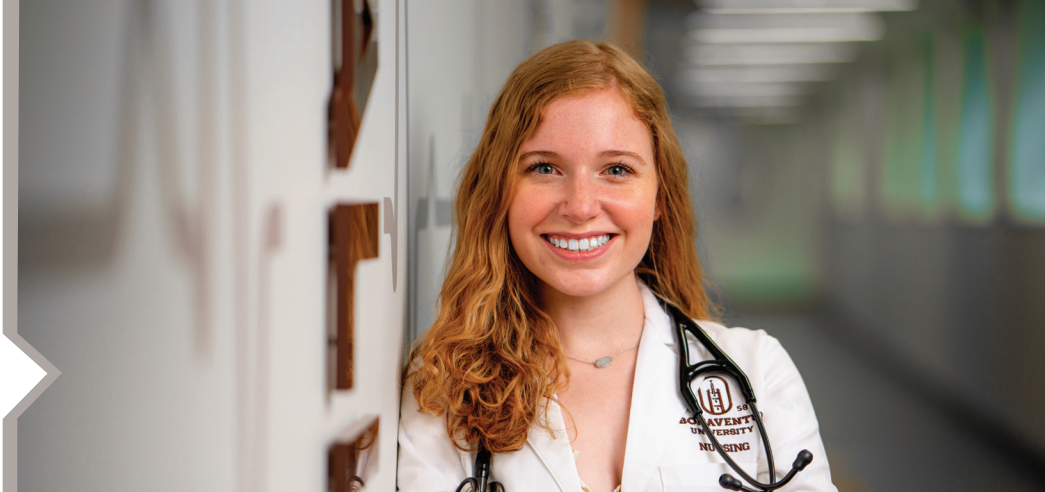

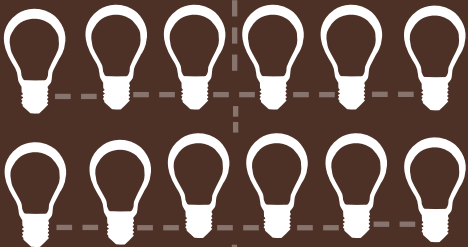
# Early Assurance for Grad School

Early assurance programs (EAP) offer high-achieving students early acceptance to a graduate-level or professional program, granting them automatic placement in the program upon satisfactory completion of their undergraduate studies.

Some EAP programs may accelerate the traditional time frame for earning both undergraduate and graduate degrees, **saving students time and money**. In all cases, EAP programs are designed to **free students from the stress and pressure of applying to numerous graduate or professional/medical programs** while they are pursuing their undergraduate degree. ## Early Preparation, Proven Results

Career preparation begins freshman year and continues throughout a student's time at SBU. The Career and Professional Readiness Center ([www.sbu.edu/CPRC](http://www.sbu.edu/CPRC)) offers opportunities for career exploration and growth to help our students succeed after they leave Bonaventure.

Our graduates are part of a network of more than 32,000 active alumni, many of whom work directly with our students to assist with internship and job placements, career advice and mentoring.

**99%**

of our graduates are employed or move on to graduate school within six months of graduation

## Outcomes

- Graduation rates are consistently **20% higher than the national average.**
- **83% Freshman-to-Sophomore Retention Rate** since 2013, significantly higher than the national average of 67% for private institutions.
