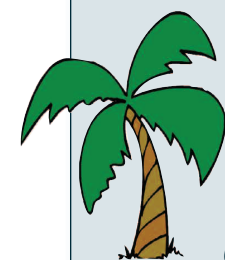
Walk, jog, bike or skate the Allegheny River Valley Trail's 6.2 miles of paved pathway along the Allegheny River from dawn to dusk.
