



## **EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP**

The School of Education at St. Bonaventure University invites applications for a tenure track Assistant or Associate Professor of Educational Leadership beginning in the fall 2010 term, subject to final budget approval.

Responsibilities will include teaching in an online hybrid format, teaching master's courses in educational leadership, academic advisement of graduate educational leadership students, supervision of graduate interns, research, and leadership of program development/improvement. Requirements include successful teaching/administrative experience in K-12 schools and higher education, a commitment to school improvement initiatives, as well as evidence of successful research, publications and grant writing. Desired experience includes (a) strong background in technology, online instruction, and distance learning, (b) commitment to and experience with quality schools and professional development sites, (c) experience with university K-12 partnerships, (d) experience with revision/design of academic programs, especially in relation to state and national accreditation, and (e) experience with and commitment to serving diverse populations. Applicants should possess an earned doctorate, although candidates who are ABD will be considered.
