



## **SPORTS STUDIES**

The School of Education at St. Bonaventure University invites applications for a tenure track Assistant Professor of Sports Studies beginning in the fall 2010 term, subject to final budget approval.

Responsibilities will include: teaching undergraduate courses in the Sports Studies and Physical Education programs, supervision of student interns in field settings, working collegially with faculty in the Physical Education department, maintaining an active research agenda, and advising students. A Ph.D. with an emphasis in exercise physiology or a related field is required; ABDs will be considered. Teaching experience at the university level is favored. Candidates with external certifications associated with ACSM, NSCA, etc. will be given preference. Candidates should possess strong pedagogical skills, experience in teaching sports skills, and be able to assist in teaching in other areas such as Biomechanics, Motor Learning and Motor Development, Assessment, and Fitness and Wellness.
