PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Additional course work is available for post-Master's Degree students seeking Advanced Certification in Community Mental Health Counseling, specifically designed for students who have earned a Master's Degree and are seeking more credits towards State Licensure as a professional counselor.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

1. Complete an application (request from the Office of Graduate Admissions)
2. Hold a Master's Degree in Counseling
3. Submit final official transcript from all graduate level work, documenting 3.0 GPA or better
4. Letter of recommendation

INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENT

In this degree program, students are expected to complete one semester-long internship of 300 clock hours with a certified counselor in an agency setting. This experience is arranged with the adviser. This experience should be discussed with the adviser early in the program so the appropriate arrangements can be made.

Students must have experience in the field prior to taking an advanced internship. Part of the advanced internship experience is to improve supervision skills.
