- > Tickets are required for the Commencement Ceremony. A maximum of 6 tickets per eligible graduate. Graduates may also request to be added to the waitlist, but there is no guarantee for extra tickets. All guests must have a ticket.
  - Please refer to the email sent from commencement@sbu.edu to officially RSVP to attend
    the ceremony and to secure your tickets online. Students do NOT need to have a ticket, only
    your guests.
  - All guests must present tickets to gain entry to the Reilly Center.
- Accessible Accommodations for guests with physical disabilities will be available upon request. The graduating student must email <u>commencement@sbu.edu</u> to arrange for special seating and parking arrangements.
- ➤ **Cap and gown** may be picked up starting Friday, May 9, at the University Bookstore. Contact the bookstore directly for more information at 716-375-2229.
  - Students unable to pick these up prior to the Commencement weekend will be able to pick up their caps and gowns on Saturday and Sunday. Refer to the Commencement website for specific times as we get closer.
