Army ROTC Overview



What is Army ROTC?

ROTC Commissions Army Officers that serve on active duty, in the National Guard, or in the Army Reserves after they obtain their bachelors degree and complete all required ROTC training.

Commissioned Officers will serve in a leadership position when they get to their first assignment. Through classroom instruction and lab training, Army ROTC prepares college students to be successful in that leadership role.









High School ROTC Scholarships

- 3 and 4 Year scholarships
- Scholarship Benefits:
 - 100% if tuition and mandatory fees
 - \$1,200 per year for books
 - \$420 monthly stipend
 - SBU Room and Board grant (covers the cost of standard dorm and meal plan)
- Opens to rising high school seniors on June 12th
- 3 scholarship boards: October, January, March
 - Each board offers scholarships to selected candidates
 - Students will get offers for 3 schools and they can choose which school they want to attend if they are accepted





Campus Based ROTC Scholarships

- 2 and 3 year scholarships
- Scholarship Benefits:
 - 100% if tuition and mandatory fees
 - \$1,200 per year for books
 - \$420 monthly stipend
 - SBU Room and Board grant (covers the cost of standard dorm and meal plan
- Awarded to college students currently enrolled in ROTC or plan on enrolling in ROTC
 - Scholarships are awarded to a select number of students every semester





Nursing ROTC Scholarships

- 2,3, and 4 year scholarships
- Scholarship Benefits:
 - 100% if tuition and mandatory fees
 - \$1,200 per year for books
 - \$420 monthly stipend
 - SBU Room and Board grant (covers the cost of standard dorm and meal plan
 - Addition reimbursement for required nursing supplies and testing fees
- Can be awarded to a student through the high school scholarship application process, or through the campus based scholarship process





Minuteman ROTC Scholarships

- 2,3, and 4 Year scholarships
- Scholarship Benefits:
 - 100% if tuition and mandatory fees
 - \$1,200 per year for books
 - \$420 monthly stipend
 - SBU Room and Board grant (covers the cost of standard dorm and meal plan)
- Awarded to currently serving Army National Guard and Reservists
 - Enlisted Soldiers that serve on a part-time basis
 - Students would then become enrolled in the Simultaneous Membership Program





Simultaneous Membership Program

- Students that are simultaneously serving in the National Guard or Reserves and while being the ROTC Program.
- Can be on a scholarship or use military education benefits for school.
- Will receive on-the-job training by working with their units leadership and a pay raise.
- The last two years, the ROTC department has seen exponential growth with the Simultaneous Membership Program by actively Recruiting National Guard Soldiers to attend SBU.





Types of ROTC Students

- Enrolled Cadet
 - Registered and enrolled in ROTC
 - Can be in the ROTC program for up to two years without signing a contract, but have no obligation to complete the ROTC program
 - Can compete for campus based scholarship
- Contracted Non-scholarship Cadet
 - Registered and enrolled in ROTC
 - Must complete all ROTC training, academic, and fitness requirements
 - Can compete for campus based scholarship
 - Receive \$420 per month stipend
 - Will commission and serve in the Army
- Contracted Scholarship Cadet
 - Registered and enrolled in ROTC
 - Must complete all ROTC training, academic and, fitness requirements
 - Scholarship benefits will be paid to the school and student
 - Will commission and serve in the Army

Train to Lead - We Commission

Tuition for Academic Year 22-23 ~\$1,135 per credit hour

Cadet Credit Hours Per Year

Freshman Year – 4

Sophomore – 6

Junior – 8

Senior - 8

*Mil History Req-3



Each Cadet Takes 29 credit hours of military science which equates to **\$29,510** in tuition revenue, in addition to their graduation requirements at SBU.

~30 SBU Cadets per year, ROTC generates **\$221,325 annually** in commissioning requirement tuition

Additionally, the University Agreement outlines an SBU University Hire in the department which has never been filled. ~45K value

Department of Military Science

Faculty Pay – \$0 Annual Budget - \$3,496 Staff Ride Trip - \$1,000

Total Annual Cost - \$4,496

<u>Total Annual Revenue - \$221,325</u>

Annual benefit to SBU - \$216,829


