Job Overview:

Paid fellowship in the WHEC-TV news department for select St. Bonaventure University Jandoli School of Communication students. Fellows work directly with experienced members of the WHEC-TV news department in a learning opportunity, where the student extends their education beyond the classroom.

Job Responsibilities:

- Learn newsgathering, writing and reporting by working with our reporters, producers, digital media manager and other news staff.
- Writes stories for station websites using such sources as broadcast scripts, Associated Press wire stories and raw news facts. Distribute original content via social networking sites.
- Assist producers with the all aspects of producing a newscast.
- Shadow producers, reporters and photographers to learn and execute job duties.
- As appropriate, take on additional news responsibilities when needed.

Qualifications:

- Must be student enrolled in the Jandoli School of Communication at St. Bonaventure University.
- Applicant needs to be in good academic standing.
- A self-starter that thrives under the pressure of strict deadline.
- Excellent research and writing skills and the ability to work effectively in a team.
- Prior knowledge using major social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter and YouTube is helpful.
- A passion for local programming and storytelling is critical.
- Working knowledge of the internet and strong computer skills are essential.
- Complies with company policies & procedures.

Process:

- Interested students should submit a resume and work samples to Prof. Anna Bulszewicz.
- Students approved by St. Bonaventure will then apply through WHEC-TV and be interviewed for the position.
- The fellowship may be extended beyond one summer or semester at WHEC-TV's discretion.
