



School Building Leader Advanced Certificate

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Program Overview

This 24-credit hour school administrator certification program (SBL) prepares elementary and secondary teachers or counselors for administrative leadership at the school building level (additional courses are required for the district level certification).

Online Format

Coursework for the School Building Leader Advanced Certificate program is 100% online.

Certification

After completing SBU's 24-credit program, the candidate is eligible to take the New York State **School Building Leader (SBL)** Administrator examination. Students may seek administration certification upon successful completion of the state examination.

Admission Requirements

Admission to this degree program is based on:

1. Teaching or Counseling certification
2. K-12 school experience (three years)
3. Official transcripts of all prior college work
4. 3.00 or better GPA
5. Interview
6. Writing sample
7. Two letters of recommendation (at least one from a principal or superintendent)

While the SBL program does not require a prior master's for admissions, students who wish to move on to the School District Leadership program after completing this MSED will be required to have at least 60 credits for the SDL certification.

Clinical Experiences Requirement

Students must complete two competency-based clinical experiences in K-12 settings, one in an elementary setting and the other in a secondary setting. The first clinical experience is the EDL 599A Practicum. The Practicum requires 200 hours. A student may begin the Practicum after three school building-level educational leadership courses are completed.

The second clinical experience is the EDL 599B Internship. The internship requires 400 hours after the Practicum is completed. One of the clinical experiences (Practicum or Internship) is to be completed at the elementary level (PK-6th grade) and the other experience at the secondary level (7th-12th grade).

Students who are teaching in K-12 school settings may be eligible to complete their clinical experiences in their own schools.

Exit Criteria

1. A cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
2. Successful completion of the practicum and internship
3. Submission of a satisfactory electronic portfolio
