Counselor Education Program Modifications

- Creation of Counselor Education Moodle Page
 - A Counselor Education Moodle Page was created so students can have one consistent location for program updates, information on comps, resources on CMHC and SC, video uploads from our virtual residency, etc.
- Creation of a Counselor Education Program Advisory Council
 - The CE Advisory Council was created to serve as a mechanism for program feedback and suggestions to the executive director and core faculty. This council consists of site supervisors, adjunct faculty, and other community members affiliated with the Counselor Education Program.
- New rubrics and DRFs in Taskstream
 - New rubrics and DRFs were created in Taskstream in the Spring 2020 semester to streamline evaluation of key assessments.
- Appointment of Taskstream Liaison
 - Dr. Luedke was appointed as the Taskstream Liaison for the Counselor Education Program. She serves as the main contact for CE faculty and student for questions related to Taskstream, and collaborates with the School of Education Assessment and Accreditation Coordinator (Dr. Rene' Hauser)

- Restructure of CE Program
 - The Counselor Education Program was restructured to better serve the needs of students, faculty, and staff. Dr. Latoya Pierce has moved from a Visiting Professor rank to an Associate Professor rank. Dr. Pierce continues to oversee the Counselor Education Program, but her title is now Executive Director. As the Executive Director, Dr. Pierce focuses more on the executive tasks of the program (curriculum development, CACREP accreditation, advisory council, professional development for students/faculty, etc.). Ms. Mia O'Brien, who formerly served as Assistant Director of the EPPC Office, is now the Director of Program Administration for Counselor Education. Ms. O'Brien's role is to assist Dr. Pierce by overseeing the daily tasks of the Counselor Education Program, serve as a program liaison, a first contact for students, and other duties as assigned. Dr. Adam Holden is serving as the Director of Student Experience, and handles dispositions, remediation, mediation between faculty and students, and other duties as assigned. Dr. Rebecca Scherer is serving as the CMHC Team Lead, and Ms. Michelle Tanner is serving as the SC Team Lead. Dr. Ashley Luedke is serving as the Taskstream Liaison for the Counselor Education Program.
- Revamped handbook
 - The CE Handbook has been updated for the 2020-2021 AY and placed on the Counselor Education Moodle Page, as well as distributed to site supervisors.
- Dispositions procedure outlined in CE Handbook
 - A formalized dispositions procedure was developed and is outlined in the updated CE Handbook.
- 1st virtual residency (Summer 2020)
 - Due to Covid-19, we held our first virtual residency this past summer. Although the residency was virtual, students participated in small groups focused on skills development on Day 3. Additionally, we were able to bring in speakers and experts from across the country due to the virtual platform.
- Faculty search to expand core faculty (resulting in 4 additional hires)
 - We have hired four additional core faculty members during the 2019-2020 AY, all of whom have officially begun their teaching assignments in the Fall 2020 semester. The search committee had a wide pool of applicants to choose from and selected faculty who demonstrated a teaching philosophy, research agenda, service to the profession, and areas of expertise that fit our faculty dynamic. We welcome Dr. Bourdeau, Dr. McLaughlin, Dr. Haugen, and Dr. Henry to the Counselor Education Program at St. Bonaventure University.
