

Visiting Assistant Professor - Anatomy and Physiology and General Biology

The Department of Biology at St. Bonaventure University invites applications for a two-year Visiting Assistant Professor position, beginning with the Fall 2021, with the potential for renewal. The position is subject to final budgetary approval.

The ideal candidate for this position is intrinsically motivated to teach undergraduate students in classroom and instructional laboratory settings. Teaching responsibilities will include contributing to our anatomy and physiology courses for life science and health science majors, and our general biology course for non-science majors, and coordinating the laboratory component of that course.

A Ph.D. is required for appointment at the Visiting Assistant Professor rank; applicants with A.B.D. status or Master's degrees will be considered for a Lecturer position. Teaching experience is desirable. Research facilities are available, and candidates will be welcome to mentor undergraduate research projects if they wish.
