

Instructions to upload vaccination proof


Dear Students,

This letter is to remind you that you **MUST PROVIDE VERIFICATION** that you received the COVID-19 vaccination prior to returning to campus. This is a requirement for all students who are attending classes on campus or residing on campus during the Fall 2021 term.



Below are the instructions on how to upload a copy of your vaccine card or other proof of receiving the vaccine:


1. Login to your patient portal at <https://sbu.mediatconnect.com/>
2. Click on the Immunization tab.
3. Scroll down to the paragraph that has the link labeled “HERE” to upload a copy of your vaccination card.



4. Once in the “Uploaded” tab, scroll down to find the “documents available to be uploaded.”




5. Choose the COVID-19 Vaccine card.



6. Select file and upload.

7. After you upload your card, return go to the Immunization tab and scroll down to the "All Required" tab.



8. Enter the dates for the vaccines you received. Please be sure to enter the dates based on the brand (i.e., Pfizer, Moderna, J&J), then click the "submit" button.

We appreciate your cooperation in completing these tasks and, more importantly, your help in keeping our campus community healthy and safe, as we return to a campus with less restrictions on gatherings and in-person contact. We look forward to having our vibrant and active campus back!
